### PRIZES AND AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place in each jump height for all classes in all Divisions excepting Chances, which is a pass/fail class. Qualifiers will receive a qualifying rosette. Anyone who achieves their NATCH at the trial will receive a special NATCH ribbon. The "RJT" award, which is in honor of Radar, Justin and Toby, who inspired the start of agility at Star City Canine Training Club, will be given to the highest combined score for each of Novice, Open, Elite and Veteran dogs from Saturday and Sunday's Regular Agility Round 1.

**NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the [NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com](mailto:NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com) list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the [www.NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com](http://www.NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com) list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.**

**LEVELS:** Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

### TRIAL INFORMATION

**ENTRY FORMS:** Our Word entry form allows you to type in your information. Please use this option as it makes it so much easier to read entry information. Please make sure your e-mail address is legible as we send out confirmations, show instructions and results to you via e-mail. The software requires both your dogs' height at the withers and the jump height in which your dog is entered. **If you have changed your e-mail, mailing address, phone number, or any other information, please highlight it on your entry form.**

**ENTRY FEES:** All classes are \$11.00 per class, \$40 for four classes each day or \$115.00 special package for all twelve runs on Saturday and Sunday. Hoopers will be an additional \$11 per run. All entries are accepted on a first-come first-served basis.

**DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES:** On Saturday and Sunday we will accept day of trial entries provided the trial has not filled. The day of trial entry fees will be \$15.00 per class with no packages. Day of trial entries will be accepted up to 12midday. It is recommended you check with the trial secretary a week before the trial to see if we are able to accept Day of Trial Entries

**ENTRY CLOSING INFORMATION:** Trial entry CLOSSES at 6:00 PM, Saturday, March 16th, 2010, or when the entry limit of 400 runs (350 jumping runs) per day is reached. Apart from day of trial entries no entries will be accepted after the closing date.

**CONFIRMATIONS:** a preliminary confirmation will be sent within a week of receipt of your premium and a final confirmation will be sent once the trial has closes. Please read over your confirmations carefully. We all make errors and we will certainly make corrections as long as we are notified prior to the final move up date after which the scribe sheets and running orders are printed.

**E-MAIL:** E-mails sent to trial secretary Ann Hogg at [ahogg552@comcast.net](mailto:ahogg552@comcast.net) will be answered within 4 days (sooner if it is a weekday). If you do not receive a response within 4 days please e-mail again. If you do not receive a confirmation within a week of sending in your entry or a week after the closing date (March 16th , 2010) please e-mail the trial secretary and let her know. **SPAM FILTERS/EARTHLINK USERS:** Please set your e-mail to receive e-mails from [ahogg552@comcast.net](mailto:ahogg552@comcast.net)

**ENTRY CHANGES:** Entries may not be changed, altered, or withdrawn after the closing date except for a dog receiving a title after the closing date may be moved up to the next higher level by notifying the secretary on or before March 22nd, 2010 at 8:00 PM. Please email move-up requests to Ann Hogg at [ahogg552@comcast.net](mailto:ahogg552@comcast.net). Please include your dog's name, NADAC #, current classes entered and the requested change.

**REFUNDS:** Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date for any reason other than bitches in heat (upon presentation of a veterinarian's statement). There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and/or a handler are dismissed from competition regardless of reason for such dismissal. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. The trial committee will leave a message on the club's answering service at (540) 344-7651 that exhibitors can check up to the day of the trial in the event the trial is canceled for any of the above reasons (including heavy snowstorm). A \$10.00 fee will be charged per dog/per day for ANY refund. The organizing committee may refuse any entry as provided through NADAC rules and regulations. Anyone not in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry in the trial.

**BAD CHECKS:** Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for bank returned checks. Illegible or incomplete entries will be returned by regular mail unless permission is given on the entry form to call collect for additional information.

Dogs must be registered with NADAC and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. To register your dog, mail the dog registration form enclosed directly to NADAC or register on line at [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com). You may also join NADAC, but you do not have to be a member of NADAC to enter the trial.

**As soon as you receive your trial confirmation, please verify that your dog's NADAC registration number is correct. Also, do the same at the trial when results are posted. Please report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.**

The management will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. **Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial,** and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform the obstacles safely.

This trial is open to all healthy, trained dogs over 18 months of age, including purebred and mixed breed dogs. Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity that may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog. **Any dog that demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial.** Any dog that the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from completion by action of the Judge or Trial Committee.

Box 1206, Colbert, OK 74733. Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels and divisions are included in the current NADAC Exhibitor's handbook.

- **Measurement will be as close to 7:30 AM as possible each day. There is no check in.**  
**Measuring**  
**All dogs entered in the Proficient Category in Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16" are required to be measured (except Veteran or Junior Handler dogs jumping 16"). Dogs jumping 20" and 20+ are not required to be measured. Dogs in the Skilled Category or dogs with permanent height cards do not need to be measured.**
- **Vendors must contact show chairs for pre-approval.**
- **We will be providing lunch and snacks for workers. If you are not working you will be able to purchase lunch from us; a grocery store and fast-food restaurants are located within 5 minutes of University grounds.**
- **Saturday to Sunday move-ups will be offered at this trial. You must hand your completed move-up form in no later than 30 minutes after the last class on Saturday.**
- **Move up forms will be available at the secretary's tent.**
- **All dogs must be ON LEAD while not competing or warming up.**
- **A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump and a short set of weave poles will be available to all exhibitors.**
- **No leads, collars, food, toys, or other aids or training devices shall be allowed on the course at any time.**
- **No food, toys, or training devices are allowed within 10 feet of the ring.**
- **Competitors are responsible for being at ringside and ready when it is their turn to run.**
- **Cleaning up after your dog is a must! Those not cleaning up will be excused from classes for the rest of the day or for the remainder of the weekend, at the discretion of the Trial Committee.**
- **Complaints by motels or Hollins University staff may result in excusal from the trial or refusal of entries in future trials offered by Star City Canine Training Club.**

### **IMPORTANT TRIAL SITE INFORMATION**

The trial will be held outdoors on grass on a soccer field. There is ample parking nearby. Parking by exhibitors is **not** permitted on the grass field.

**10 minute** unloading will be allowed on South Campus Drive. Due to the narrowness of the road that runs next to the trial site, vehicles may be parked for unloading before the trial and loading after the trial for a maximum of 10 minutes. Please do not do any setting up or tearing down of your tents, crates, etc., while your car is parked alongside the road. Roadside parking is limited to the time it takes to remove items from your vehicle at the start of the trial and to put items back into your vehicle when you are leaving the trial. Thank you for your cooperation.

Limited space is available for overnight RV parking in the parking lot behind the agility field. Tents are allowed and are recommended, as there is no shade adjacent to the trial site, but must be set up no closer than 20 feet of the ring. Tents may be left overnight at your own risk. Please bring your own water for your dog. Set-up will be allowed after 2:30 PM on Friday.

### **RING AND EQUIPMENT:**

Ring size is 100 feet by 100 feet. Obstacles that may be used in the trial may include: Dog Walk, A-Frame, Open Tunnel, Weave Poles and Non-Wing Jumps and Hoops. **Our contact equipment is now covered with rubber.**

**The trial will be held outdoors on grass at the Hollins University Soccer Field.**

**A research pond near the show site is off limits! Dogs caught in the pond will be excused from the trial, and any injuries from snapping turtles or other hazards are the complete responsibility of the owner/handler.**

## DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

The trial will be held outdoors on grass at the Hollins University Soccer Field. Hollins is on U.S. Route 11 (7916 Williamson Road, Roanoke, VA 24019), just off Interstate 81 at Exit 146. When you arrive at the campus entrance, turn left and take West Campus Drive all the way to the back of the University grounds. [www.hollins.edu/admissions/visit/visit.htm](http://www.hollins.edu/admissions/visit/visit.htm)

- From the north on I-81, take Exit 146, turn left on to Plantation Road go to the first stoplight and turn left on to Williamson Road (Route 11 north), go approximately ½ mile, turn left into the campus entrance.
- From the south on I-81, take Exit 146, turn right on to Plantation Road, go to the first stoplight and turn left on to Williamson Road, go approximately ½ mile, turn left into the campus entrance.
- From Lynchburg, VA, Route 460 west, turn right on to Alternate 220 and travel approximately 5 miles to the intersection of Alternate 220 and Route 11, turn left at the stoplight and travel south on Route 11 for about 3 miles, turn right into the campus entrance.
- From Greensboro, NC, take Route 220 north until it runs into I-581 north. Travel 5.4 miles on I-581 until it intersects with I-81 north, take Exit 146 and follow directions from the south on I-81.
- From Covington, or Hot Springs, VA, take Route 220 south until it intersects with Route 11, turn right at the stoplight and follow Route 11 for 3.5 miles, turn right into the campus entrance.
